## **Ronald McDonald House Charities Announces New Staff Member**

Paula Duke to Oversee Ronald McDonald Family Rooms Program

AUSTIN, Texas – (June 19, 2012) – Ronald McDonald House Charities of Austin and Central Texas (RMHC Austin) is pleased to announce **Paula Duke** as the first Family Room Program Manager. As the newest member of the RMHC Austin staff, **Duke** will be the manager, coordinator and liaison between the three Family Rooms and the hospitals in which they are located.

The creation of this new staff position follows a period of rapid growth for RMHC Austin which has opened all three Family Rooms since 2009, two of them within the last twelve months.

The Ronald McDonald Family Rooms are home-like places for families with children in the intensive care units. There they can rest and regroup within the walls of the hospitals. RMHC Austin has three Family Rooms to serve the needs of Austin and Central Texas families: One location at St. David's Women's Center of Texas on the campus of North Austin Medical Center, a second location at Dell Children's Medical Center of Central Texas, and the newest location at St. David's Medical Center.

**Duke**, a native Texan with a background in education and math, joins the RMHC Austin team after spending the past several years raising four boys. Prior to taking time off to focus on her family, **Duke** worked at Dell and United Way. Although her boys keep her busy, Duke has made time to volunteer at RMHC Austin, the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation, and her children's schools. She currently serves on the board of Hope 4 JD.
