### **Providing Burial Assistance**

Ronald McDonald House Charities of Central Texas<sup>®</sup> has always gone beyond lodging and support services to help families. Since 1993, RMHC CTX's Healing Hearts program has supported Central Texas families who have lost children due to illness or injury.

Suffering the loss of a child is a devastating sorrow. At times, families faced with this tragic loss do not have the financial means to cover the cost of properly interring their child. Through our Healing Hearts program, we ensure families are provided burial assistance to help ease the financial burden.

#### **Helping Families Cope**

RMHC CTX hosts bereavement counseling programs to help families who have lost children. Hospice Brazos Valley and Mending Hearts Grief Center will guide and comfort families in a private space as they cope with the loss of their child.
