

WHO WE SERVE

The Ronald McDonald House welcomes up to 30 families every night. Each room accommodates six family members. Families at the House must live 25 miles or more away from the hospital.

Ronald McDonald Family Rooms, located inside Central Texas hospitals, are available to all families with a hospitalized child, ages 21 and under, regardless of where they live. Families may stay overnight in our Family Room sleeping rooms.

The Happy Wheels Cart supports families waiting by their child's hospital bedside.

Healing Hearts helps Central Texas families who have tragically lost a child.

HOW WE HELP

The Ronald McDonald House is a "home-away-from-home" for

families. Family stays at the Ronald McDonald House vary from a single night to a year or more • Families are referred by hospital staff • Daily meals are prepared by volunteers • Snacks and beverages are always available • Families may donate \$20



per night for their stay but are never turned away if they can't donate 📍 Many amenities are available including computers, laundry facilities, fitness center and children's play area 🌱 The House is open 365 days a year, 24 hours a day

Ronald McDonald Family Rooms provide a refuge from the hospital

environment. Family Rooms are located close to the NICU or PICU Amenities include snacks and beverages, laundry facilities, sleep rooms, children's play area and computers Hospitals refer families to the Family Rooms Hours vary at each hospital Volunteers and supporters will occasionally donate meals There is no fee to use or visit the Rooms

We rely on a **network of volunteers** who help at the House, Family Rooms and Happy Wheels Carts.

The Happy Wheels Cart strolls the hospital hallways bringing complimentary items to families with hospitalized children. • Juice, snacks, small toys and toiletries are

provided to comfort families waiting by their child's bedside

When a family tragically loses a child, the Healing Hearts program provides burial assistance and bereavement counseling by a licensed counselor.

Holiday House Hero - You can make the holidays festive for families staying at our "home-away-from-home" during the season. Holiday House Hero Sponsorship: \$10,000 per month (for November or December)

Happy Wheels Cart - Designed to support families with children healing in the hospital, the Happy Wheels Cart strolls hospital hallways bringing a bit of comfort to families waiting by their child's bedside. Volunteers man the carts and distribute complimentary items like snacks, juice, small toys and toiletries to children and families. Annual Sponsorships to Stock Carts: \$2,500 - \$5,000

Emergency Hospitality - Ronald McDonald House Charities of Central Texas maintains an emergency hospitality fund. When a child becomes suddenly ill or is hurt in an accident, parents find themselves in need of a place to stay with no time to plan. When our 30-guest room House is fully occupied, our Emergency Hospitality Fund provides financial assistance to help secure a reduced-rate hotel room for families during their children's treatment.
