FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is the entry fee for the event?

A: Entry is \$1,000/squad (4 shooters) or \$250/person. If you are unable to join us for the sporting clay competition, a \$40 dinner ticket is available.

Q: What does my entry fee include?

A: Entry fee includes beverages, snacks, dinner and shotgun shells.

Q: What is the goal for this year's event?

A: Our goal is to raise \$100,000.

Q: How will the funds raised at the event be used?

A: Proceeds raised at the Sporting Clay Classic will support Ronald McDonald House Charities of Central Texas' four programs that comfort families who have critically ill or injured children.

Q: Will prizes be awarded?

A: Scoring will be based on the Lewis Class system. The 1st, 14th and 27th ranked squads will receive prizes. The first place squad will also receive the coveted Sporting Clay Classic traveling trophy to display for the next year. The top man and woman shooter will each receive a prize.

Q: How can I participate in this year's event?

A: Register a squad
Register as an individual shooter
Be a sponsor of the event
Volunteer at the event

Q: Do I need to provide my own guns and ammunition?

A: Participants are responsible for bringing their own guns, but ammunition and targets are provided. Please bring eye and ear protection for the course. Eye and ear protection will be available if needed.

Q: What type of guns are recommended?

A: Only 12 and 20 gauge shotguns are permitted. 410 and 28 shotguns are permitted but participants must provide their own ammunition.

Aim High for our Children and Families

Q: How do squads travel the course?

A: Squads will be able to walk between stations on the course. Golf cart rides will be available for those that are unable to walk the course.

Q: Do I need to be an experienced clay shooter?

A: Shooters of all levels are welcome.

Q: Will guidance be on the course to help novice shooters?

A: Each station will have a pro shooter to help instruct and keep each group safe in handling and shooting a firearm. Shotgun instructions will be provided by each pro shooter.

Q: Can I have less than four people on my squad?

A: Yes, however squads are recommended to have four shooters to create an even playing field. If you would like individuals to be assigned to your squad to fill your four places please let us know.

Q: Will I be placed on a squad if I purchase an individual ticket?

A: Yes. Individual ticket purchasers will be matched to fill squads of four.

Q: Are restrooms provided on the course?

A: Yes, restrooms will be throughout the two courses.

Q: Will beverages be provided on the course?

A: Alcohol may not be consumed prior to shooting. Water and non-alcoholic beverages will be provided to take on the course and will be available at various stations. The pavilion bar will open at 4 pm.
