Additional responsibilities will include but are not limited to coordinating meals, special events, database entry, solicitations and administrative duties. Being a medical free facility, our internships do not provide students with medical related, child directed or counseling opportunities.

Duties:

- Serve at least one shift inside an area hospital in a Family Room or pushing the Happy Wheels Cart.
- Promote customer service by assisting with families at the Ronald McDonald House.
- Assist with data entry and maintaining accurate records for each program.
- Coordinate logistics for Hospital meal programs.
- Assist with inventory needs at each location.
- Assist with volunteer recruitment planning and correspondence.
- Strategize with Hospital Programs team to find and develop new meal sponsors.
