WALKING OUT, FULLY HEALED

When five-year-old Owen began to feel ill in December 2018, his parents Kristin and Darin Coulter never dreamed that he would be on life support after a harrowing trip to the hospital only days later.

Owen was placed on life support after 90 minutes of CPR due to myocarditis (a virus that attacked his heart). Kristin and Darin were in shock, until a social worker from Dell Children's Medical Center pulled them aside and said that she had arranged for a room right next to the hospital at Ronald McDonald House.

Knowing that they would have a place to stay so near to Owen's bedside provided an immediate

sense of relief for the family who lives an hour's drive away. When they checked into their room on December 14th, they were pleasantly surprised to find their room had been sponsored by the Round Rock Express and outfitted with a large chalkboard. As their family gathered that day, they wrote down an important intention: "Owen will walk out fully healed." 56 days later on February 7th, the Coulters realized their vision when Owen went home with his family.
